From the flaming red canyon walls of Flaming Gorge to the millions of years of exposed history in the Geological Loop, this ride should not be missed. The ride continues to north-western Utah to return via gorgeous Mirror Lake Highway, which climbs over 10,500 feet and a includes a stop at Provo Falls. 	22	<p>Buckskin/Mink Creek (following GT HOG Meeting at Dixie's Diner)</p> <p>This ride takes us through some great riding from Pocatello to Inkom via Buckskin Road, then Mink Creek Road to the Arbon Valley. 	23	<p><b>National Parks</b></p> <p>Some folks can't make all of our Saturday rides, so we have a few Sunday rides scheduled. Grand Teton National Park is the namesake of Grand Teton HOG Chapter, and this ride pays homage to two of the best National Parks in America – Grand Teton NP and Yellowstone NP. As a day ride, we will ride over Teton Pass, through GTNP including the Jenny Lake Loop, then through Yellowstone.
